## PUBLIC FORUM WORKSHOP

The Public Forum Workshops are a new requirement of the 2012 City Charter. This change is to allow a better understanding of the budgets and to allow discussion between the Council, Department Managers, and the Public. The last Public Forum Workshop will be held October 29<sup>th</sup>.

From the adopted City Charter:

**Expense Budget.** 5.06 [a] (3) (ii) On or before November 1st: The City Manager will have each City Department Head present a written detailed Expense Budget Report to both the City Council and the City's citizens in a public forum where both the City Council and Caribou's citizens can ask questions and provide input to the City Manager and each Department Head.

Capital Expense Budget. 5.06 [b] (3) (ii) On or before November 1st: The City Manager will have each City Department Head present their written detailed Capital Expense Budget Report to both the City Council and Caribou's citizens in a public forum where both the City Council and Caribou's citizens can ask questions and provide input to the City Manager and each Department Head.

Mayor Murchison opened the Public Forum Workshop and commented that this is the second Public Forum Workshop to be held under the new City Charter. The Mayor noted that both Councilors and the public will be able to ask questions as Department Managers give an overview of their proposed 2013 budget.

The following Department Budgets and Capital Expense Budgets were reviewed. All questions from the Council and members of the public were answered by the Interim City Manager, Department Managers, and Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors.
