

**RESOLUTON 2014-1  
EXTENDING CABLE TELEVISION FRANCHISE**

WHEREAS, the City of Caribou, Maine and Time Warner Cable Northeast LLC (“Time Warner Cable”) entered into a Franchise Agreement on July 1, 1996; and


WHEREAS, the parties wish to extend the term of the Franchise Agreement to January 28, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, as the Franchising Authority, having examined the financial requirements of its access operations, has determined that there is a need to increase the franchise fee to help with operational costs associated with the operation of its access channel in addition to the need for replacement camera equipment in the amount of \$5,665; and

WHEREAS, Time Warner Cable has reviewed the proposed increased operational costs and capital needs;


NOW THEREFORE, after due and full consideration, the City Council and Time Warner Cable agree as follows:

1. As compensation for this franchise in consideration of permission to use the streets and public ways of the City for the construction, operation, maintenance and reconstruction of the cable television system, Time Warner Cable shall pay the City a franchise fee in the amount equal to five percent of the Time Warner Cable’s gross annual receipts from all sources attributable to the operations of the franchise to provide cable service within the City, including but not limited to pay cable, and any lump sum connection fees.
2. Within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this ordinance and subject to signature by Time Warner Cable, Time Warner Cable shall remit a PEG Access Capital grant in the amount of \$5,665 to the City.
