## **REGISTRATION FOR THE 2021 CARIBOU FALL ARTS & CRAFTS FESTIVAL** *Sponsored by the City of Caribou*

**DATE & TIME:** The 2021 Caribou Fall Arts & Crafts Festival will be held in the gym and cafeteria of the Caribou High School on **Saturday, October 16, 2021 from 10 am to 4 pm and Sunday, October 17, 2021 from 10am to 4pm.** Exhibitors will be allowed to set up after 6 am on Saturday morning.

**DISPLAY PROHIBITIONS:** Exhibitors will receive a copy of our rules and regulations. Any exhibitor found circumventing these rules will be prevented from participating in future Caribou Arts and Crafts Fairs. The rules are not subject to interpretation and the final decision will be made by City of Caribou. Displays must be set up by 10 am on Saturday, October 16 and cannot be dismantled prior to 4 pm on Sunday, October 17.

**RESERVATION OF SPACE:** For the two week period immediately following the 2021 festival, participating crafters will receive reservation preference on a first come first serve basis. All other space requests will be placed on a waiting list.

Space size is approximately 8' wide by 5' deep in the cafeteria; cost is \$68 per space. Spaces along the gym wall have electricity and are 8' wide by 7' deep, cost is \$78 per space. Spaces in the middle of the room are 9' wide by 7' deep in the gym; cost is \$78 per space.

Those who wish to register for the 2022 show may do so anytime during the 2021 event and will be eligible for a \$10 discount per space. Acceptance of an exhibitor's reservation assumes compliance with the sponsor's guidelines.

Those who do not reserve by November 1st are not guaranteed spots or locations for the following festival.

If you've paid and are no longer able to participate, full refunds will be granted through August 30, 2021.

**LIABILITY & PROTECTION:** The City of Caribou the Caribou School Department and their employees will not be held responsible for any injury or for any loss by fire, theft, damages, and/or delay because of mechanical or electrical failure, labor trouble, or any other act which might occur during the Caribou Arts & Crafts Festival.

Crafters are NOT to leave money at their booth overnight Saturday; the City of Caribou is not liable.
