

Mechanic

The City of Caribou is seeking applicants for the position of Mechanic in its Public Works Department.

Applicants must have a minimum of a High School Diploma or equivalent. A Trade School Degree in Mechanical, Diesel or Automobile maintenance is helpful. Must be physically able to meet the demands of the position and capable of working long hours when required. Own tools required. Class B CDL and a Pre-Employment Drug & Alcohol Test is required. The public works department is looking for a mechanic that can diagnose and repair simple and complex problems with construction equipment for small gasoline engines. The successful candidate must be able to use welding and a cutting torch for equipment repairs and fabrications. The successful applicant will be working on construction equipment such as dump trucks, front end loaders, backhoes, sidewalk equipment, snow blower equipment, pickups and cars, and a variety of small gasoline equipment.
