

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE

Please take notice that the Caribou High School, Eastern Aroostook RSU#39, 75 Glenn Street, Caribou, Maine 04736, telephone number 207-496-6311 is intending to file an amendment to their Stormwater Management permit with the Maine Department of Environmental Protection pursuant to the provisions of 38 M.R.S.A. § 420-D. The permit will be filed on or about April 5, 2023.

The applicant is proposing to reconstruct their existing 6-lane 440yd running track, as well as associated facilities. A 30' x 30' storage building is proposed for construction at a future date as is a 36' x 68' modular classroom with surrounding walkways and ramps. Currently the site is developed and is home to the Caribou High School campus located at 308 Sweden Street, Caribou.

A request for a public hearing or a request that the Board of Environmental Protection assume jurisdiction over this application must be received by the Department, in writing, no later than 20 days after the application is found by the Department to be complete and is accepted for processing. Public comment on the application will be accepted throughout the processing of the application.

The application will be filed for public inspection at the Department of Environmental Protection's office in Bangor during normal working hours. A copy of the application may also be seen at the municipal offices in Caribou, Maine.
