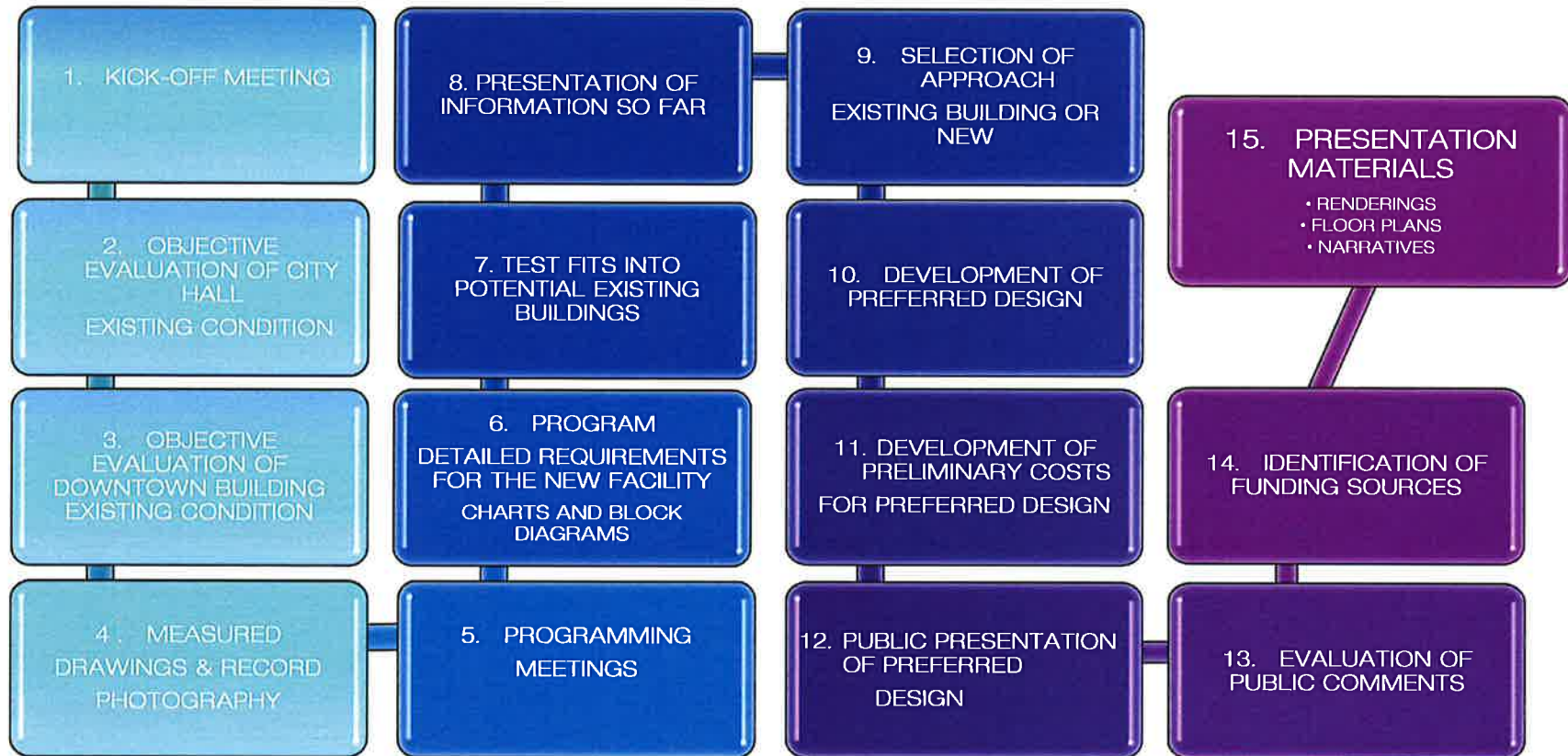

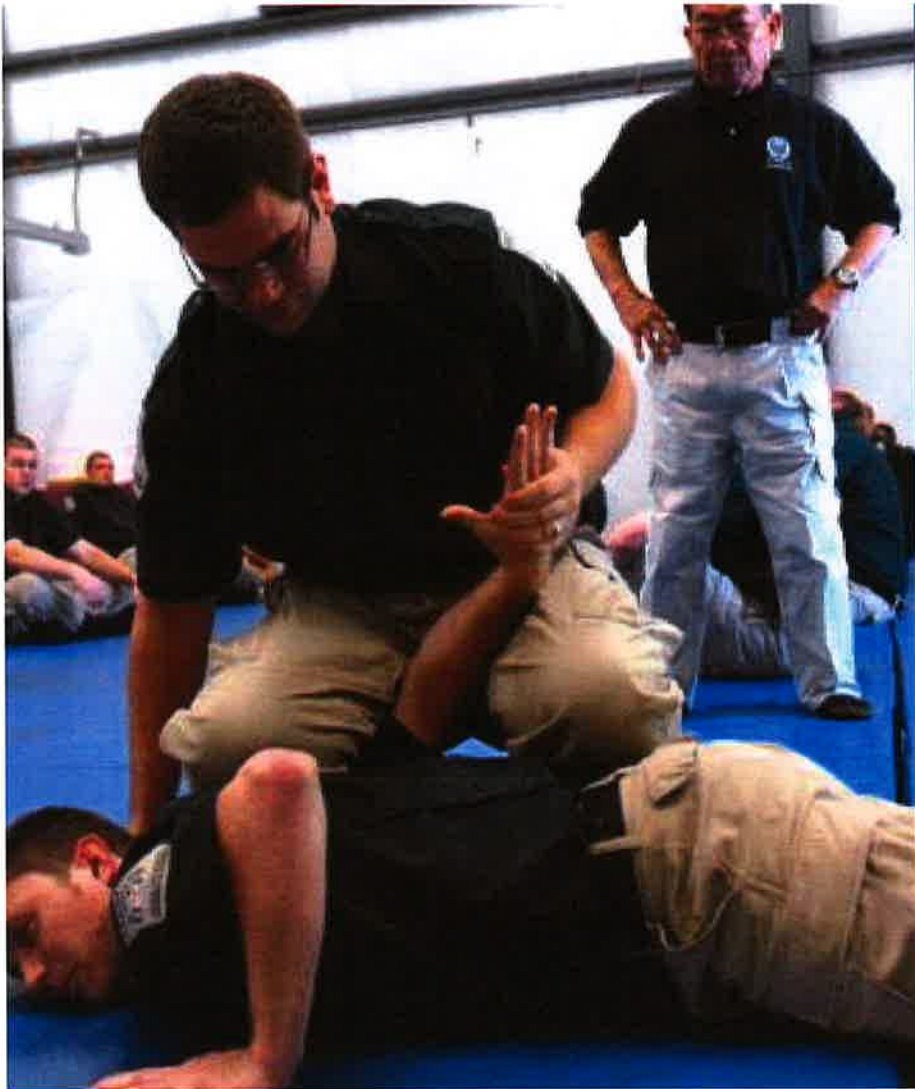

OPEN MEETINGS TRANSPARENCY

FACEBOOK

1. Get your officers and City staff to LIKE and RECOMMEND both the City and the Police pages.
2. Post something (with a photo) everyday – no matter how short
3. Let people know what is happening in the process
4. It is an easy place for folks to get quick info and you need to get ahead of the crowd

WEB PAGES

1. UPDATE your City website – create a section just for the Police Station/City Hall process.
2. Post all available information
